SCHOLARSHIPS FROM LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS

FCCLA LEADER'S SCHOLARSHIP – CONVAL CHAPTER – Family, Career and Community Leaders of America \$500 scholarship to be awarded to a student who has shown exceptional leadership qualities and is enrolled in post-secondary education for the 2010-2011 school year in one of the following focus areas: culinary, early childhood education, entrepreneurship/business, fashion design, hospitality or interior design.

Deadline: May 30, 2010

FUTURE EDUCATORS ASSOCIATION - CONVAL CHAPTER - \$500 scholarship to be awarded to a graduating senior from ConVal who has been a member of the Future Educators Association, enrolled in a post-secondary institution for 2010-2011 and has a passionate interest in education. This scholarship is not based on financial need.

Deadline: May 30, 2010

LOCAL GOVERNMENT CENTER – 10 - \$1000 scholarships to be awarded to high school seniors of NH municipal, school county and village district employees who are members/participants in the aNH Local Government Center's services. Requires an essay (*How the Economy has Impacted the Budget and Services of My Community or School District*) and 3 letters of reference.

Deadline: March 1, 2010

ROBERT C. BYRD HONORS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - Primarily awarded to students having attained a high degree of academic excellence throughout their high school career. Not based on financial need. Typical awardees are ranked top 3 of their class, have a 4.0 GPA (4.0 system) and SAT's of 1200 or better. Student must be U.S. citizen or national, resident of New Hampshire, high school graduate, planning to enroll as a full-time student at institution of higher education. Scholarship awarded solely on the basis of demonstrated outstanding academic achievement (rank-in-class, GPA, SAT scores) and explanation of projects and/or awards. Amount of scholarship is \$1,500.

Deadline: April 5, 2010 (receipt not postmark)

ABBOTT AND FENNER SCHOLARSHIP - \$1000 scholarship to be awarded, essay required. More information available at:

BUILDERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP – \$500 scholarship sponsored by Home Builders and Remodelers Association of Southwest NH. This is a logo design contest open to all students of secondary and post-secondary schools. More information available in Guidance office.

LAKES REGION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP - \$1000 scholarship available to NH residents enrolling in a tourism, marketing, restaurant and/or hospitality program.

NH ASSOCIATION OF EDUCATIONAL OFFICE PROFESSIONALS SCHOLARSHIP – Julia T. Pingree Student Scholarships awarded to high school seniors who are planning to attend college and major in business. BEST BUY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – 1,000 - \$1,500 scholarships to be awarded to students with solid grades and involved in community service or work experience. Apply at www.bestbuy.com/scholarships or www.at15.com

Deadline: February 15, 2010

BURGER KING SCHOLARS PROGRAM – Scholar Awards of \$1000 each given to high school seniors for first year college/post-secondary education expenses. Requires a minimum 2.5 GPA, must have worked an of 15 hours/week, actively involved in community service activities and having financial need. Deadline: February 10, 2010

GOOGLE ANITA BORG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP for FIRST YEARS - \$10,000 award for the 2010-2011 academic to be awarded to a high school senior intending to be enrolled as a full-time student at a US university (this includes international students) in a computer science, computer engineering, software engineering or related program. JANICE M. SCOTT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - 6 - \$2,500 memorial scholarships to be given to high school seniors in memory of Janice Scott who was killed in the terrorists attacks on September 11, 2001. Criteria considered include need, academics, community service and writing skills. Information and application in Guidance office.

Deadline: March 31, 2010

KFC COLONEL'S SCHOLARS PROGRAM – Up to \$5000 awarded to a senior planning to pursue a bachelor's degree at a public institution in NH, must have a 2.75 GPA (4.0). Information and application available at www.kfcscholars.org

Deadline: February 10, 2010

NATIONAL DAR SCHOLARSHIPS – A variety of scholarships offered through the National DAR; all applications require a letter of sponsorship from local DAR Chapter.

Deadlines: February – August, 2010 (most are February 1, 2010)

SKRUNGLOO FARM, INC. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – established to help individual NH residents educate and better themselves in order to build a stronger community. Applicants must demonstrate financial need, academic merit and other non-academic factors such as community service, school activities and work experience. FAFSA required.

Deadline: March 1, 2010

STEPHEN PHILLIPS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – Renewable scholarships of \$3,000 to \$10,000/year given to students with a 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale), top 20% of class, able to demonstrate meaningful contribution to society, involved in balance of community, school and work activities and demonstrate financial need.
