### Important Information

There are many important decisions facing the school district this time of year... One in particular involves the bond proposal to renovate portions of the high school.

The work covered by the bond is work that has to be done to bring our high school up to code. If the voters pass it now it will cost the district \$4 million, if we wait, state aid will disappear and the district will have to pay \$8 million later.

Another is the proposed operating budget for the 2010-2011 school year totaling \$ 43,798,819. If the budget is defeated the district will have to operate on the default budget of \$43,543,965, which is the same as this years operating budget.

We hope that families will become more informed about these important issues before going to the polls in March.
