--CVHS AYP stands for ConVal High School 's Annual Yearly Progress. NHEIAP equates to New Hampshire Education Improvement Assessment Program. NCLB means No Child Left Behind.

--For two years now, CVHS has had students in one of the specified five student categories (Educational Disability/ED) not meeting AYP in the area of Math. This makes CVHS officially a "School In Need of Improvement". This means that among other things, parents must be notified of this fact. Additionally, a two year School Improvement Plan is required.
