

Contoocook Valley School District Policy

RECOGNITION OF ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT (SAU) SCHOOL BOARD

- A. SAU SCHOOL DISTRICT: The pre-existing School Districts of Antrim, Bennington, Dublin, Frankestown, Greenfield, Hancock, Peterborough, Sharon and Temple shall constitute the Contoocook Valley Regional School District, also known as SAU #1.
- B. SAU BOARD: The Contoocook Valley Regional School Board is the SAU Board.
- C. POWERS AND DUTIES: The SAU Board is empowered to:
1. Elect, when necessary, a Superintendent.
 2. Act upon the Superintendent's nominations for SAU professional staff.
 3. Fix the salaries of all SAU personnel.
 4. Adopt a budget for the expenses of the SAU.
 5. Adopt policies affecting the SAU.
- D. ELECTION OF SAU PROFESSIONAL STAFF: When a vacancy occurs in the SAU professional staff, the Superintendent is responsible for recruitment, and submitting a recommendation to the School Board.
- E. EMPLOYMENT OF OFFICE PERSONNEL: All other SAU personnel shall be recommended for employment by their immediate supervisor and approved by the Superintendent of Schools.
- F. NON-DISCRIMINATORY POLICY: The SAU Board does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, age, marital status, handicap, or national origin in the educational programs or activities which it operates and that are required by Titles VI and IX.
- G. ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY: The Superintendent of Schools is the chief executive officer of the school district and, in his absence, the Assistant Superintendent will act as deputy chief administrative officer with the same power and responsibilities as vested in the Superintendent.
