With its roots in the Education Forum held a number of years ago, this plan's focus is on the students of the ConVal School District – their growth and development – in grades K through 12 and beyond. The plan details six major goals, each having several key indicators to be used in evaluating its success.

Our Local Education Improvement Plan (LEIP) reflects the extensive and thoughtful work done by members of the ConVal community through the Education Forum as well as recent work done by district staff and administrators. We believe the LEIP provides for a consistent, district-wide approach to improving student growth, yet allows for each school to maintain its individuality and its own culture. The LEIP reinforces our commitment to make the necessary investments into the educational product that benefits not just our students, but the entire ConVal community, as well. We believe the LEIP will be a valuable tool to maintain and further improve our reputation for excellence in the state of New Hampshire.

The LEIP is a long-term plan that will require patience, resources and support. It will continue to evolve over a five-year cycle with involvement from students, parents, staff, community members, board and administrators. We will revisit it several times each year, check on our progress and make any necessary adjustments.
